Mohan Kumar is currently the CEO and Managing Director of Strides Pharma Global Pte Ltd, headquartered in Singapore. With an illustrious career spanning over four decades, he has played a pivotal role in shaping the global pharmaceutical landscape.

Kumar began his professional journey in pharmaceutical marketing in 1978 after completing a Bachelor of Science degree in Physics, Mathematics, and Chemistry from the University of Kerala, India, followed by a postgraduate degree in Business Administration from the University of Calicut. His career took a transformative turn in 1990 when he joined the newly formed Strides Pharmaceuticals in Mumbai, contributing to its evolution into a multinational enterprise listed on the Bombay and National Stock Exchanges of India.

In 2000, Kumar relocated to Brazil to lead Strides' operations, overseeing its expansion into new markets. In 2006, he moved to Singapore as the CEO and Managing Director of Drug Houses of Australia (DHA), a subsidiary of Strides. Under his stewardship, DHA experienced phenomenal growth, leading to its eventual merger with an Australian pharmaceutical company and subsequent acquisition by Watson Pharmaceuticals USA for USD 393 million, now part of Teva Pharmaceuticals.

After a brief return to India in 2013 as the global CEO of Strides, Kumar established the company's international headquarters in Singapore in 2015, with support from the Economic Development Board (EDB). He continues to oversee the headquarters' operations, ensuring Strides remains at the forefront of innovation and excellence in the pharmaceutical industry.

Beyond his corporate role, Kumar actively contributes to the community. He currently serves as Chairman of the Life Sciences Industry Group under the Singapore Manufacturing Federation, is a Council Member of the Federation, a member of the National University of Singapore Medicine International Council, and a supporter of charitable causes through the Sree Narayana Mission.
